

There is nothing quite like the taste of fresh fruit straight from the garden. Add to this the satisfaction and sense of achievement, the savings, the knowledge that your fruit is free of nasty pesticides and you have some very powerful reasons for growing your own.

Pest and Disease Control in Fruits

Most gardeners want to harvest good crops relatively free of pests and diseases, grown in a safe environmentally sustainable manner.

You, the home gardener want:

- Good yields, relatively free of pests and diseases
- Using best garden practices to minimise pests and diseases
- Using only safe environmentally friendly products
- Using products that are commonly available in home garden size packs and are legally registered

Minimising Pest and Disease

Using good basic gardening practices to minimise pests and diseases is essential for gardeners whether conventional or organic. In simple terms, providing the best growing conditions to ensure a strong healthy crop. The following are the simple basics:

- Grow fruit suitable to the area and choose disease resistant varieties.
- Add lots of compost and work into the soil.
- Provide adequate balanced feeding sheep manure pellets and a general garden fertiliser.
- Water during dry periods.
- Practice good garden hygiene by removing all diseased leaves and fruit.

Using Disease Resistant Varieties

Whilst a few 'Heritage' varieties may have disease resistance, modern varieties are more likely to be better. Using disease resistant varieties will ensure better crops, greatly minimising the need to use fungicides. Modern varieties are also likely to yield more and taste better. This is especially true of apples.

Using Pesticides

If good gardening practices are followed and disease resistant varieties used, use of pesticides can be minimised. There are a range of very low toxicity, environmentally friendly pesticides available to home gardeners. Always read product labels and follow directions and precautions and check withholding periods for each product and each crop.

Synthetic Pesticides

Follow our recommendations which are accurate and comply with legal/registration requirements. Enviro friendly garden pesticides are - Grosafe Free Flo Copper, Grosafe Enspray 99, Mavrik, Success Ultra.

Natural Organic Pesticides

Some natural organic pesticides are very safe eg Grosafe Enspray 99, Yates Natures Way. Others are more toxic than synthetic pesticides eg Derris Dust & Pyrethrum. Just because a product is natural and organic does not mean it is safe. Some natural organic products are more toxic and pose greater risks than synthetic alternatives.

Prevention is better than cure. Once you have gained experience and are aware of what pests and diseases attack which crops, you will be able to anticipate and spray at the first sign, which is more effective and minimises pesticide use.

Black spot, curly leaf, brown rot and codling moth are good examples of where early treatment at first sign is effective, but if left until the problem builds up, pesticide use is ineffective.

What to Use

Birds and Animals

The only effective measure is to cover with netting.

Insects
